## SCSO seeks public's help locating missing/endangered juvenile

Seminole Co. (Feb. 26, 2017) - The Seminole County Sheriff's Office (SCSO) is asking the public for help locating missing/endangered 14-year-old Samantha DaSilva.

At approximately 3 p.m., Samantha and her sister left their home located in the 2900 block of Willow Bay Terrace in unincorporated Casselberry, to go to a nearby park. At around 4:30 p.m., Samantha's sister returned home, but Samantha was not with her. Family members are concerned about Samantha's well-being, as she recently made threats to harm herself.

Samantha is a white female, 5'3' tall, weighs approximately 120 lbs., with short gray or partially gray hair and brown eyes. A photo is attached to this release. She was last seen wearing a dark blue sweatshirt with AEagle (American Eagle Outfitters) lettering on it and light colored blue jeans.
