Two juveniles arrested for burglarizing vehicles in Lake Mary

Seminole Co. – (March 8, 2017), This morning at approximately 12:40 a.m., Seminole County Sheriff's deputies responded to the 700 block of Brightview Drive, in unincorporated Lake Mary, for a report of a vehicle burglary. Upon arrival, deputies spoke to the victim who indicated a neighbor contacted her after witnessing four suspects burglarize her vehicle. The suspects took electronics, change, and various gift and credit cards from the unlocked vehicle and fled the scene on bicycles.

During a search of the area, an abandoned bicycle was discovered at a nearby residence next to several bushes. A K-9 unit responded and immediately located two suspects hiding under the bushes. Both juvenile suspects, identified as Kameron Myers and Cedrick Williams, were taken into custody without incident and placed under arrest. As deputies searched Myers, they found a LG brand tablet that was reported stolen from another vehicle in the area.

Myers and Williams were transported to the Seminole county Juvenile Assessment Center. Myers was charged with Burglary and Loitering. Williams was charged with Burglary and Probation Violation.

Two suspects believed to be involved in the vehicle burglaries are still outstanding at this time. Anyone with information is asked to call the Seminole County Sheriff's Office at (407) 665-6650 or Crimeline at (800) 423-TIPS (8477). Calls made to Crimeline remain anonymous, and tips that lead to the felony arrest of suspects and/or the recovery of stolen property and drugs are eligible for cash rewards of up to \$1,000 dollars.
