Suspect arrested for Aggravated Battery on person over 65 years of age

Seminole Co. – (May 1, 2017) – Seminole County Sheriff's deputies arrested Lenetria Dixon for Aggravated Battery on a person over 65 years of age. The investigation began on April 12 at approximately 1:50 p.m. when deputies responded to Wekiva Springs Road and Fox Valley Road in unincorporated Longwood for a report that a vehicle struck a Sheriff's Office School Crossing Guard. Upon arrival, deputies spoke with the crossing guard who indicated a tan Ford Taurus travelling at a slow rate of speed entered the crossing walk as he was crossing children. The crossing guard attempted to gain the driver's attention and alert her to stop, but the vehicle continued to move towards him without yielding. The front bumper of the vehicle then struck the crossing guard in the leg while the driver was trying to go around him. He explained that he had to quickly move out of the way to avoid being run over, but was uninjured.

Witnesses and the crossing guard provided deputies a description of the female driver and a tag number of the vehicle, which was registered to Dixon. On May 1, 2017, Dixon agreed to meet with deputies to discuss the incident. During the interview, she admitted to seeing the crossing guard in the crosswalk and driving around him to get to a gas station located adjacent to the incident location. Dixon was then placed under arrest and charged with Aggravated Battery on a person over 65. She and booked into the John E. Polk Correctional Facility and remains incarcerated on a no bond status.
