SCSO seeks help locating missing/endangered man

Seminole Co. (Sept. 12, 2017)-The Seminole County Sheriff's Office (SCSO) is asking the public for help locating a missing and endangered 69-year-old man.

Thomas Steven McMaster was last seen at approximately 1 p.m. today when he left his home on Bracken Court in unincorporated Winter Park on foot. According to family members, Mr. McMaster has Alzheimer's and is without his medication. Mr. McMaster recently relocated to the Winter Park and may not be familiar with the area.

Mr. McMaster is a white male, 5'8" tall, and 150 pounds. He has gray hair and blue eyes. **A photo is attached to this release.** He was last seen wearing blue pants, a blue long sleeve shirt with the cuffs rolled up, and white and green sneakers.
