Suspect arrested for sexual battery of a child under twelve

Seminole Co. Fla. (October 1, 2018) - Seminole County investigators have arrested a local man for sexual battery of a child under twelve.

The charges stem from an ongoing investigation into allegations that 23-year-old Jahnard Bonamy of Apopka, sexually assaulted multiple young children, all who'd been babysat at an Altamonte Springs home the suspect shared with his girlfriend and her mother. Investigators believe the women were unaware of the abuse.

On Thursday, a child disclosed that Bonamy sexually battered her on multiple occasions in the home located at 682 Acapulca Way in unincorporated Altamonte Springs. Bonamy is suspected of assaulting two other young children also at that location. All of the children had been babysat in the home between August of 2015 and April of 2018, at which time the subjects were evicted from the home.

Bonamy was arrested Friday without incident and transported to the John E. Polk Correctional Facility where he is being held without bond.

Seminole County investigators believe there could be more victims and are asking anyone whose child was babysat in that home or had contact with Bonamy to call (407)665-6650.
