#### **SCSO investigating homicide and missing/endangered person**

SEMINOLE CO. (October 20, 2014) - Investigators with the Seminole County Sheriff's Office are asking the public for information about a homicide which occurred yesterday afternoon in the 3000 block of Woodley Park Place in Oviedo. Investigators are also asking for the public's assistance in locating the victim's 20 year-old son and a vehicle missing from the home.

On Sunday at approximately 3:45 p.m., deputies responded to the residence after receiving a call about an unresponsive female. Arriving deputies found the victim, Jacqueline Suzanne Ortiz, 45, inside the home. She was pronounced deceased on scene by the Seminole County Fire Department.

Investigators are looking for the victim's son, Joshua Galin Ortiz, who may be traveling in the victim's white, 2005, Ford Mustang convertible, tag number G521UU. The vehicle has noticeable front end damage. Joshua Ortiz is considered missing and endangered, as he has made suicidal statements.

Joshua Ortiz is described as a white male, date of birth 08/04/94 and resides in the residence on Woodley Park Place. He was last seen wearing a black shirt with the words "LA Boxing" in red and camouflage shorts.
