SCSO seeks information in attempted homicide - 03/27/2012

Seminole Co. Fla., (3/27/12)-The Seminole County Sheriff's Office is asking for information from the public regarding an attempted homicide that occurred last night in the unincorporated area of Sanford. Deputies were called to the area of Beardall Avenue and Lincoln Street at approximately 6:30 p.m. after receiving a report that a man was being beaten by two other men with blunt instrument. Deputies found the victim, a 50-year-old white male, inside the woods on the north side of Lincoln Street near Beardall Avenue. He was transported to Orlando Regional Medical Center where he is currently in critical condition.

Investigators believe the victim was originally beaten inside his vehicle, a black SU V, and was then taken into the woods where the two men continued to attack him with the blunt instrument. The men then left the area in the victim's vehicle and abandone dit a short distance away.

Investigators are searching for two Hispanic males, both approximately 20 years of ag e. One of the men was 5'8" and wearing blue denim shorts and no shirt. The second m an was 5'10."
