

CIVIL SERVICE BOARD MINUTES

The Civil Service Board of the Seminole County Sheriff's Office met on December 6, 2022 via Microsoft Teams and at the Seminole County Sheriff's Office. The Board Members present were Retired Major David Diggs (in person), Detention Deputy Taurus Burke (in person), and Ms. Dawn Kraus (in person). HR Director Robert Hunter (remote) and Sr HR Analyst Shelley Curenton (in person) were also present.

The meeting started with a call to order at approximately 4:01 pm with roll call.

The minutes for the previous meeting, held on November 1, 2022, were reviewed. Taurus Burke made a motion for approval of the minutes. Ms. Krause seconded the motion. The minutes were unanimously approved.
