SCSO seeks public's help in identifying bank robber - 05/08/2013

SEMINOLE CO. (May 8) – The Seminole County Sheriff's Office is seeking the public's help in identifying a bank robber who held up the Chase Bank at 5601 Red Bug Lake Roa d in Winter Springs at approximately 4:40 p.m. this afternoon. The man is described as a white male, approximately 6 feet tall, 170 pounds, with blondish hair and a goat ee. He was wearing a black ball cap, plaid shirt, black shoes, and sunglasses.

This afternoon at approximately 4:20 p.m., deputies responded to the Trustco Bank at 1295 Tuskawilla Road where witnesses reported a man wearing a ball cap and sunglasses entered the bank, behaved strangely, and then left without making a transaction. Sho rtly after arriving on scene at the Trustco Bank, deputies were alerted to a bank rob bery at the Chase Bank nearby. Witnesses at the Chase Bank advised that a subject ma tching the same description had just passed the teller a note, implied he had a weapon, and left with an undisclosed amount of cash.

The man reportedly got into the passenger side of a champagne/gold Saturn Vue with Te xas tags. The vehicle had tinted windows. At least one additional person was belie ved to be in the vehicle.
