## Three burglary suspects caught leaving the scene with stolen presents - 12/18/2013

SEMINOLE CO. (Dec. 18, 2013)-Seminole County Sheriff's deputies arrested three suspe cts yesterday for burglarizing a home in the Druid Estates subdivision in Maitland, S eminole County. At approximately 11:00 a.m. an SCSO investigator was conducting proa ctive patrols in the area when he witnessed the suspects loading several large bags o f goods into a gold Ford Explorer parked in the driveway of a home on Westchester Dri ve.

The investigator initiated a traffic stop on the vehicle after he witnessed the drive r run several stop signs. The driver refused to pull over and fled at a high rate of speed. Another SCSO unit in the area deployed stop sticks near Druid Road and Oranol e Road. The suspect swerved in an attempted to avoid the stop sticks and crashed int o a brick wall.

The driver, David Smith, 25, of Sanford, was entrapped in the vehicle and extricated by the Seminole County Fire Department. He was transported to the Orlando Regional M edical Center with non-life threatening injuries.

The two remaining suspects bailed from the vehicle, hopped over the brick wall and continued to flee on foot. They attempted to hide in a tree, but were tracked down by the Orange County Sheriff's Office K-9 unit. Quinton Chambers, 24, and Shamoule Bridges, 21, both of Apopka, were subsequently taken into custody without further incide nt.

Deputies recovered the victim's belonging including cash, jewelry and Christmas prese nts intended for her children. Deputies also found a stolen handgun, burglary tools a nd drugs in the vehicle.

Chambers and Bridges were booked into the John E. Polk Correctional Facility on multi ple charges of burglary, grand theft, and drug possession. Smith faces additional ch arges of driving with a suspended driver's license and fleeing and eluding. He remai ns hospitalized at this time.
