Seminole Co., Fla. (Oct. 3, 2016) - The Seminole County Sheriff's Office (SCSO) will be participating tomorrow in the 33rd National Night Out (NNO) - an annual event designed to strengthen community and law enforcement partnerships and involve citizens across the country in crime prevention efforts. Tomorrow evening, citizens are asked to turn their porch lights on in support of the NNO, and

join community celebrations taking place in their neighborhoods and throughout the county.

This year members of the public are invited to celebrate National Night Out with us by stopping by one of three locations between 6 p.m. and 9 p.m., to visit with crime prevention deputies and other Sheriff's Office personnel. Tell the neighbors, bring your kids, and come out for this fun and exciting annual event. SCSO events will be held at the following locations and are free to attend:

- BJ's Wholesale Club (4270, State Road 46, Sanford) Deputies will be showcasing SCSO's airboat and the antique Sheriff's vehicle. Members of the Crossing Guard Program will provide games, bicycle helmets, and locks. There will also be face painting, a "Justice League" bounce house, and a special appearance by McGruff the Crime Dog.
- Chik-fil-A (3050 E. Semoran Blvd., Apopka) Deputies, K-9 Amber, and the Chik-fil-A Cow will be welcoming residents. Children will also get the opportunity to "Paint a Patrol Car" and play inside a "Frozen" themed bounce house.
- Target (820 Oviedo Mall Blvd., Oviedo) Deputies and Carl the Safety Bear will be
 out greeting visitors. Face painting, a bounce house, and balloon creations will be
 available for the children.

At each location, there will be several local vendors, food, drinks, give-away items, bounce houses, and much more! Two children's bicycles will be raffled off at each event - you must be present to win. Additionally, SCSO's Alert helicopter will be making a landing at the BJS Wholesale Club and conduct fly overs at the other locations. We look forward to connecting with members of our community tonight!

The purpose of NNO is to enhance the relationship between neighbors and law enforcement while bringing back a true sense of community and provides a great opportunity to bring police and neighbors together under positive circumstances.
