Two suspects arrested for stealing chainsaws and possession of marijuana

Seminole Co. (Jan. 26, 2018) – Seminole County Sheriff's deputies arrested two suspects for their involvement in the theft of chainsaws from a construction trailer located in the parking lot of Aldi Food Store located at 4160 W. SR 46 in unincorporated Seminole County.

On January 25 at approximately 1:14 p.m., a witness advised she saw a subject take the chainsaws from the trailer and place them in the back of a vehicle. The witness provided deputies a description of the suspect, the vehicle tag number, and advised the vehicle left the parking lot traveling east on State Road 46.

The Communication Center ran the tag which came back to an address on Wilner Circle in Sanford. Deputies responded to the address and located the vehicle parked in front of an apartment building. Two men were standing by the vehicle with one of them matching the witness' description. Deputies approached them and smelled marijuana coming from the vehicle. Deputies searched the vehicle and located two stolen chainsaws and a scale with marijuana residue.

The subjects were identified as Julius Bennett, 21, of Sanford and Cornelius Davis, 22, of Jacksonville. Both were taken into custody. After being placed in the back of the patrol vehicle, deputies discovered Davis was concealing marijuana in his mouth.

Bennett was arrested for burglary and grand theft. Davis was arrested for possession of marijuana, possession of drug paraphernalia and destruction of evidence. Both were booked into the John E. Polk Correctional Facility.
