Man Charged in Sanford Shooting

Seminole Co. Fla., (03/01/2018) -The Seminole County Sheriff's Office yesterday charged Jorge Colon-Hernandez, 61, of Orlando with attempted felony murder.

Last night, at approximately 7:20 p.m., deputies responded to 2275 Marquette Avenue in unincorporated Sanford, in reference to report of a shooting with injuries. Upon arrival, they discovered Danilo Espinosa, 48, of Sanford, with a non-life-threatening wound to his abdomen.

Investigators determined that Espinosa was working in an auto body shop located on the property when Colon-Hernandez entered the business, and an argument ensued. Colon-Hernandez was armed with a handgun and fired one round at Espinosa striking him in the lower abdomen area. Colon-Hernandez then left the body shop and went to a recreation vehicle he owns on the property.

Deputies ordered Colon-Hernandez to exit the recreational vehicle. He complied and was taken into custody without incident. Colon-Hernandez was arrested for attempted felony murder and booked into the John E. Polk Correctional Facility where he remains incarcerated with no bond.

Espinosa was transported to a local hospital where he was stabilized and underwent surgery to repair his injuries. He remains hospitalized in stable condition.
