Corrections captain resigns after posting inappropriate photos online

Seminole Co. Fla., (03/01/2018) -The Seminole County Sheriff's Office today announces that after learning of the commencement of a preliminary investigation into the posting of inappropriate photographs of himself on social media accessible to the public, Joseph Klinger, a captain who was assigned to the the Department of Corrections as a corrections supervisor, tendered his immediate resignation.

"I am extremely disappointed in Klinger's actions which are contrary to our agency's core values," said Sheriff Dennis Lemma.
