

SCSO seeks the public's help in locating a missing 78 year-old man - 01/09/2012

Seminole Co. Fla., (01/09/12)-The Seminole County Sheriff's Office is asking the public for help in locating a missing and endangered 78 year-old-man.

Donald Gullickson (W/M DOB 6/1933), was last seen at approximately 11 p.m. last night by family members at his residence near the 700 block of Silver Birch Place, Longwood. Mr. Gullickson has not driven in nearly two years, however family members believe he left his home in a 2002 navy blue Lincoln Town Car bearing tag P456TC. Family members also informed investigators that Mr. Gullickson suffers from Alzheimer's. Mr. Gullickson had recently moved into the Silver Birch area after relocating from Altamonte Springs. He recently spoke to family members about his desire to go to the mountains and has family in the Lake Lure area near Charlotte NC.

Mr. Gullickson is 6" tall with Gray hair, blue eyes and weighs approximately 330 pounds. He was last seen wearing dark jeans, a dark pullover shirt, and may be wearing a grey and red hoodie style jacket.
